

How Measure A Funds Would be Used

The Palo Alto Unified School District plans to use the revenue from each Measure A \$493 parcel tax payment to:

Maintain Programs Supported by the Expiring Parcel Tax Approved by Voters in 2001:

\$ 212 (43% of Measure A revenue) – Maintain current K-10 class size

\$ 154 (31%) – Avoid teacher layoffs

Restore Some Programs and Services Lost or Reduced in Prior Funding Cuts:

\$ 50 (10%) – Reinstate some secondary school classes

\$ 19 (4%) – Restore some staff for K-12 instructional programs and school site support

\$ 18 (3.5%) – Restore some guidance and counseling services

\$ 15 (3%) – Restore certain K-5 literacy and art programs

\$ 14 (3%) – Restore certain K-12 instructional materials

\$ 9 (2%) – Restore some librarian hours

\$ 2 (0.5%) – Restore some teacher training
